Sermon Notes

SERMON DISCUSSION

1. Paul tells Titus to "put what remained into order" by appointing elders (v.5). Where have you seen that good leadership brings order, health, and mission-focus in a church — and where have you seen the opposite? (1 Peter 5:1–3)
2. Most qualifications are about character more than talent (vv.6–8). Which one do you most want in your leaders — and which one do you most need to grow in yourself? What's one concrete step you could take this month?
3. Paul ties leadership credibility to integrity at home (v.6). What does it look like for the gospel to shape a person's life "close to the ground" (marriage, parenting, relationships, reputation)? How can the church support and protect leaders' families rather than consuming them?
4. Walk through the "not..." list (v.7). Which of these sins is easiest to excuse in our culture (arrogance, quick temper, greed, etc.)? What guardrails help prevent a slow drift before it becomes public damage? (James 1:19–20)
5. Elders must hold firm to the Word to both encourage and correct (v.9). What does it look like for a church to be a place where truth is loved, correction is received without defensiveness, and disagreements are handled with gentleness?
