# Sermon Notes

## SERMON DISCUSSION

1. Paul moves from doctrine to ordinary life. Does that connection tell us something about the purpose of doctrine? (cf. 1 Tim. 1:5; 2 Tim. 1:13)
2. Why is "self-control" (or sobriety) so repeated here? Are there things in your life that erode self-control?
3. Why does Paul put so much weight on older saints teaching younger saints? (vv.3-5) What is the difference between "older women likewise..." and a generic "everyone should disciple everyone"? What strengths does life-stage discipleship bring? (cf. Ps. 145:4; 2 Tim. 2:2)
4. Why is credibility so important? (vv. 5, 8) What's the difference between protecting our own reputation and protecting the reputation of the gospel?
5. How do servants/workers principles (vv. 9-10) translate into employee/employer life today (honesty, respect, not pilfering, showing good faith)? Is how you work making Christ attractive?
