2. What does this command challenge about the way we naturally think about government or authority?
3. Are there any similarities or differences between how you think about being subject to civil governing authority and church authority?
4. What might it look like in your everyday life to “be ready for every good work”?
5. What helps prepare us to live this way?
6. Verse 2 gives several defining marks that should define how Christians interact with others. Which of these is the most challenging for you personally? Why?
7. How can Christians disagree with people and still live out the defining marks of verse 2?
8. Consider all of Paul’s instructions in these two verses. Which one of these areas is God prompting you to grow in right now? How can our group pray for you in that?
