# Sermon Discussion

1. James says that true religion consists of three things. What are they and why are they important?
2. What does it mean to “think one is religious” but not control the tongue? Check out Matthew 12:34-37. Why is the tongue an indicator of spiritual health?
3. In what ways can we deceive ourselves about the quality of our walk with God? Where might you be tempted to feel “okay” because of outward activity, while ignoring heart-level transformation?
4. James highlights care for orphans and widows and personal holiness. Why do you think both are needed for “pure and undefiled” religion? (Micah 6:8, Isaiah 1:16–17, 1 John 3:17–18). Who are those in your life that are vulnerable, overlooked, or marginalized that you need to pursue?
5. What does it look like in your everyday life to be “unstained from the world”? See Romans 12:2, John 17:15–18, Titus 2:11–14. Where are you most tempted to conform to the values of the world?
