## New Here?



# Sermon Discussion

1. Paul emphasizes that God forgave “all our trespasses” (v.13). Practically speaking, how does believing in total forgiveness shape the way you respond when you sin? How can you actively remind yourself of your new status as one fully forgiven in Christ?
2. Verse 14 says our debt was nailed to the cross. Yet we often live as if this debt still burdens us. What debts — past sins, mistakes, or regrets — do you find yourself still trying to repay on your own? What steps can you take this week to rest in the fact that Christ fully paid that debt?
3. Jesus does not remove Satan from the world, but disarms him. He can no longer accuse and condemn believers for unforgiven sin. What can he do? What can't he do? See Hebrews 2:14-15.
4. Paul says Christ “disarmed the rulers and authorities” (v.15). Consider areas in your life where you feel defeated by habitual sins, anxiety, or fears. How can recognizing Christ's victory practically empower you to face these struggles differently today?
