Sermon Discussion Questions

We Can Trust the Bible 2 Timothy 3:16-17

- 1. What is the relationship between trusting the Bible and obeying the Bible?
- 2. What causes us to doubt the trustworthiness of the Bible?
- 3. Throughout 2 Timothy, Paul is instructing Timothy to avoid "foolish disputes" (2:23) and to warn the people not to "quarrel about words" (2:14) and to "preach the word" (4:2). So, there is this sense that there is a friction between the truth of God's word and competing ideologies. How do we see that present in our day, and how do maintain faithfulness and avoid "foolish disputes"?
- 4.It is not unusual for us to feel illequipped to do the work of the Lord. What are ways that the Scriptures equip us to serve the Lord?
- 5. Given the inspiration of Scripture, the Bible is unchanging and authoritative. How is this an encouragement to us as followers of Christ?
