SOMETHING WORTH LIVING FOR - ACTS 9: 19 - 31

1. Read 1 Peter 3:15. What is the reason for your hope?
2. What did Saul give up in order to follow Jesus? (Phil 3:4-6) Culturally, why is this significant?
 - a. What have you had to give up to follow Jesus? How did that feel?
3. Why do you think Saul continued to preach the gospel, despite the threats on his life?
4. Acts 9:19-31 depicts Saul living out the words he later pens in Philippians 3:7-14. Share how you have found Jesus to be surpassingly greater than the things of this world.
5. How are you doing at sharing Jesus with those around you? Would you say you are living on mission (for Jesus) or living for the world?
 - a. How would those closest to you answer this question for you?
6. What are you going to do this week to live a life that reflects your belief that Jesus is worth more than everything in this world?
7. Who in your life are you praying for opportunities to share the gospel? Close your discussion time by praying for one another and the people each of you are praying for - pray that the gospel will go forth through each of you.
