Sermon Discussion Questions


When God Spoke
Genesis 1-2

1. Genesis 1-2 is primarily discussed as a battle over whether you believe modern-day science or the Bible? Have you had these discussions with people? What kind of questions do you have about the account of creation in Genesis?
2. How can we read Genesis 1-2 without forcing it to fit our modern understanding of scientific/historical writing?
3. In what ways do the creation accounts of Genesis provide a counter-narrative to modern secular views of creation?
4. How does God's pronouncement that creation is "very good" inform our view of the material world? How does the pronouncement call for our wise stewardship (v26-28)?
5. God the Father is the Creator (Genesis 1:1) who works with the Spirit (v.2) by the power of his Word (v.3) to create the heavens and the earth. Since Jesus taught all of Scripture points to him, how does creation find its ultimate expression in Christ? (See John 1, Colossians 1:15-ff)
6. What can you say are the non-negotiables about the creation account that we are supposed to take away from reading Genesis 1-2?
