Sermon Notes

SERMON DISCUSSION

1. When you picture a healthy church, what's at the non-negotiable center? How would you rank these around that center — and why?
 - a. Gospel essentials / Doctrinal distinctives / Cultural preferences
2. Unity is easy when people bend toward you. How far are you willing to bend toward another person?
3. Unity doesn't say "anything goes." It says: within confessional bounds, sincere Christians may disagree. Where is Paul's "line"? What makes something not a Romans 14 matter (cf. vv. 17, 20–21)? Give examples of when liberty goes too far.
4. Paul argues that he is "fully convinced" of his position (v.14), but then argues that people can do the opposite of what he is fully convinced about. How can Paul/us be ok with contradictory views in one church?
5. In mixed conviction settings, what specific steps will you take so your words and choices don't become a "stumbling block" to brothers/sisters who differ (vv. 13, 15, 20–21)? How does your answer promote "righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit" (v.17)?
6. Pick a theological sticking point like baptism. When this issue surfaces in our church, how will you teach with persuasion (v.14) yet refuse to "destroy...for the sake of" winning the point (vv. 15, 20)? How will you model charity while stating your view?
7. Why doesn't Paul tell Jewish and Gentile believers to form separate churches? How would separation undermine:
 - a. The gospel welcome (cf. 14:3; 15:7)?
 - b. Witness to a divided world (14:19)?
 - c. Discipleship into maturity (bearing with the weak, 15:1)?
