





Sermon Discussion Questions

Prince of Peace Isaiah 11:1-10

- 1. Read Isaiah 11-12. Consider the goodness of God's promise presented in chapter 11 and the response of chapter 12. Spend some time together sharing evidences of God's goodness and faithfulness in your life. Give thanks to God for his faithfulness to his promises.
- 2. What does it look like for us to live as citizens of the Kingdom of God? Consider Matthew 5-7. How can our life and conduct make known the Lordship of Jesus?
- 3. It is clear from verse 10 that the Messiah has a global mission. How are we participating in that? How are we called to participate?
- 4. The Messiah has humble origins that serve to highlight God's power. God often works through weakness to accomplish his plans. He often works through means that run contrary to contemporary 'wisdom'. How is that a comfort to us? Consider 2 Corinthians 12:9. Why is it that God often works this way? What does it mean to boast in the Lord?
- 5. One author has said, "In the message of Israel's prophets, the themes of judgment and salvation are forged tougher by the mighty acts of YHWH'. Where is this driving our attention? Where is it that God's judgment and salvation are ultimately forged into one?
